

1899-1900 MAP of RIDGEFIELD VILLAGE

This map, used to determine where the town's new sewer system would be installed, is useful because it shows property owners in the village in the late 1890s, as well as the locations of buildings. Note that some roads bore different names then, such as Hawley Street (today's Branchville Road), Ramapoo Road (Gilbert Street) and Middle Ridge (East Ridge Avenue). The map was scanned in many pieces from one printed by the town clerk's office with an old silver-based photostat copying system. Over the years the silver images of the words, streets and other markings have faded, and have been digitally enhanced for this reconstructed image.
