DECLARATION **OF SENTIMENTS**

WE HOLD THESE TRUTHS TO BE SELF-EVIDENT:

that all men and women are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness: that to secure these rights governments are instituted, deriving their powers from the consent of the governed.

THE HISTORY OF MANKIND IS A HISTORY OF REPEATED INJURIES

and usurpation on the part of man toward woman, having in direct object the establishment of an absolute tyranny over her.

...WOMEN DO FEEL THEMSELVES AGGRIEVED, OPPRESSED,


and fraudulently deprived of their most sacred rights, we insist that they have immediate admission to all the rights and privileges which belong to them as citizens of these United States.

IN ENTERING UPON THE GREAT WORK BEFORE US.

we anticipate no small amount of misconception. misrepresentation, and ridicule: but we shall use every instrumentality within our power to effect our object. We shall employ agents, circulate tracts, petition the State and national Legislatures, and endeavor to enlist the pulpit and the press in our behalf.

We hope this Convention will be followed by a series of Conventions, embracing every part of the country.
