

INDEX TO DICK'S DISPATCH

Richard E. "Dick" Venus wrote 366 "Dick's Dispatch" columns in *The Ridgefield Press* between March 13, 1982, and Nov. 16, 1989, covering life in Ridgefield in the first half of the 20th Century.

In 1996, the Ridgefield Archives Committee, forerunner of the Ridgefield Historical Society, compiled all 366 columns by photocopying clippings of the columns as they appeared in *The Press*. The massive project didn't end there: Someone — we haven't figured out who — undertook the arduous task of indexing the contents. The result, which appears below, contains more than 3,000 entries requiring over 17,400 words!

This index has been digitally scanned from the original print version. A few spelling and typographical corrections have been made, but otherwise this is the same index that is in the photocopied edition of the columns, which were "published" in loose-leaf binder format.

Over the past six years, the columns themselves have been scanned, converted to digital text, and compiled in searchable PDF format. These PDF files are available for download on the historical society website, ridgefieldhistoricalsociety.org, and are also downloadable from the "Files" section of the Old Ridgefield group's home page on Facebook.

These 366 columns were also posted over the past six years on Old Ridgefield, where they can be read by searching the term "Dick's Dispatch."

Note that the indexer cites many illustrations that accompanied the columns appearing in *The Press* and that were included in the photocopied compilation. Some of these illustrations were included in the 366 Dick's Dispatch postings on Old Ridgefield, but often, different or additional ones were employed. (No images were included in the PDF compilations; those are text-only files.)

The original illustrations may be viewed in the photocopied binder edition, available at the Ridgefield Library and the historical society. Many may also be viewed in digitized issues of *The Press* available at news.google.com/newspapers, although quite a few of these images may be less crisp than they were in the original newspaper. All of the columns and their images may also be viewed on microfilm available at The Ridgefield Library.
